

## Family Worship QT Guide (English Translation)

### **Worshiping God Alone**

Scripture: Numbers 33:51-54 (June 5 Passage)

Prayer:

God, help us to fear You and delight in worshiping You. Let us gain wisdom and strength from Your Word and live in a way that pleases You. May You reign wherever we are, and help us firmly remove anything that replaces You. Let us love and serve You alone, and enjoy the blessings You give us.

Hymns:

- Hymn 357 - Rise Up, O People of God
- Praise - I Will Love Only the Lord

Reflection Questions:

- What was the first thing the Israelites had to do when entering Canaan? (v. 52)
- What do I need to organize or remove so that I can worship God alone without hindrance?

Insight:

God commanded the Israelites entering Canaan to do two things: First, destroy idols and drive out the inhabitants who worshiped them, for they must worship God alone. Second, divide the land by casting lots, distributing it according to the number of people, establishing fairness and justice.

### **Lessons Learned in the Sanctuary**

Scripture: Psalm 73:16-19 (June 13 Passage)

Prayer:

God, thank You for gathering us in this blessed place of worship. Help us to hold fast to Your unchanging Word and be victorious in faith in this ever-changing world. Thank You for showing that a life lived according to Your Word is never in vain. Let us strive to do what is right before You, not seeking human approval, knowing the end of those who live arrogantly and without God.

Hymns:

- Hymn 545 - Even Though I See No Evidence
- Praise - Refine My Heart Like Pure Gold

Reflection Questions:

- What did the psalmist realize only after entering the sanctuary of God? (vv. 17-19)
- What personal commitment can I quietly uphold as a child of God, even if others do not understand or recognize it?

Insight:

God judges those who live arrogantly and do evil. Although evildoers seemed to prosper while the righteous suffered, the psalmist realized in the sanctuary that the end of the wicked is judgment.

### **Passing the Word to the Next Generation**

Scripture: Psalm 78:1-4 (June 20 Passage)

Prayer:

God, thank You for letting us rely on Your perfect love in this imperfect world. Let us receive Your Word in faith and live by its wisdom. Thank You for allowing us to walk the path of faith together. Help us diligently teach the next generation who You are so they may stand firm on the rock of faith.

Hymns:

- Hymn 199 - My Beloved Book
- Praise - I Want to Be the Joy of the Lord

Reflection Questions:

- What teaching did the psalmist want to pass on to his generation and the next? (v. 4)
- How did I come to know and believe in God? Who should I share this experience with, and what would I say?

Insight:

The psalmist passed on the Word of God learned from ancestors so that the next generation would remember God's glory and mighty deeds. Just as our spiritual forebears passed down God's Word

to us, we must pass it on to the next generation.

## **Open Wide the Mouth of Faith**

Scripture: Psalm 81:9-16 (June 27 Passage)

Prayer:

God, thank You for giving us breath and allowing us to praise You. Let us worship You with all our hearts and listen intently to the Word of life. Thank You for adopting us as Your children and promising great grace and blessings. May our whole family become people of faith and obedience who reject what You forbid and do what You command, enjoying the blessings You've promised.

Hymns:

- Hymn 449 - I Will Follow Jesus
- Praise - By Faith I Will See Your Face

Reflection Questions:

- If the Israelites had listened to God's Word and followed His way, what would God have done for them? (vv. 14-16)
- God wants us to open wide our mouths and seek Him (v. 10). What kind of prayer do I want to offer to the God who can meet every need?

Insight:

God led Israel out of Egypt to be their God. He promised to defeat their enemies and feed them with the best food if they rejected idols and opened their mouths in faith. Sadly, their disobedience kept them from enjoying God's blessings.
